
Surah 1 - The Opening - Al Fatihah (This *surah* has been called the very essence of the Qur'an; its seven *ayah* or verses have a special role in daily prayer, being recited at the start of each unit of prayer; when recited, the Surah Al-Fatiha is usually followed by the word *Amin*, i.e., Amen; a calligraphic style presentation of the Arabic phrase, "In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful" precedes each *surah* in the Qur'an; English translation with a transliteration of the original Arabic. The *Qur'an* verses based on translation by Abdullah Yusuf Ali.)

1:7 The way of those on whom Thou hast bestowed Thy Grace, those whose (portion) is not wrath, and who go not astray.
