

Notes on Gabra Finn

Gabra: nomadic herding people – 30,000 in northern Kenya – 52,000 square miles (area size of Holland) one of the most barren tracts of desert in the world, less than eight inches of rainfall annually

encyclopedic knowledge, identifying 450 species of plants and have 177 laws governing the herding of cattle and goats, grasses and watering – “**finn**” living with and respecting nature
