all RMG venues and will guarantee your entry time; book your ticket in advance online.

Cutty Sark and Royal Observatory tickets can be purchased for either individual site (£16 adult) or a day pass (£25 adult, £16 student) that admits you to both.

CUTTY SARK

–timed entry ticket for climbing the rigging (2 levels) includes admission

NATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM

–timed entry ticket required; £0

QUEEN'S HOUSE

–timed entry ticket required; £0

ROYAL OBSERVATORY

–timed entry ticket includes the observatory and access to the Prime Meridian

13.30 Ride Bus 129 to North Greenwich (every 11–14 min.; 15-min. ride)

GETTING THERE

GREENWICH FOOT TUNNEL

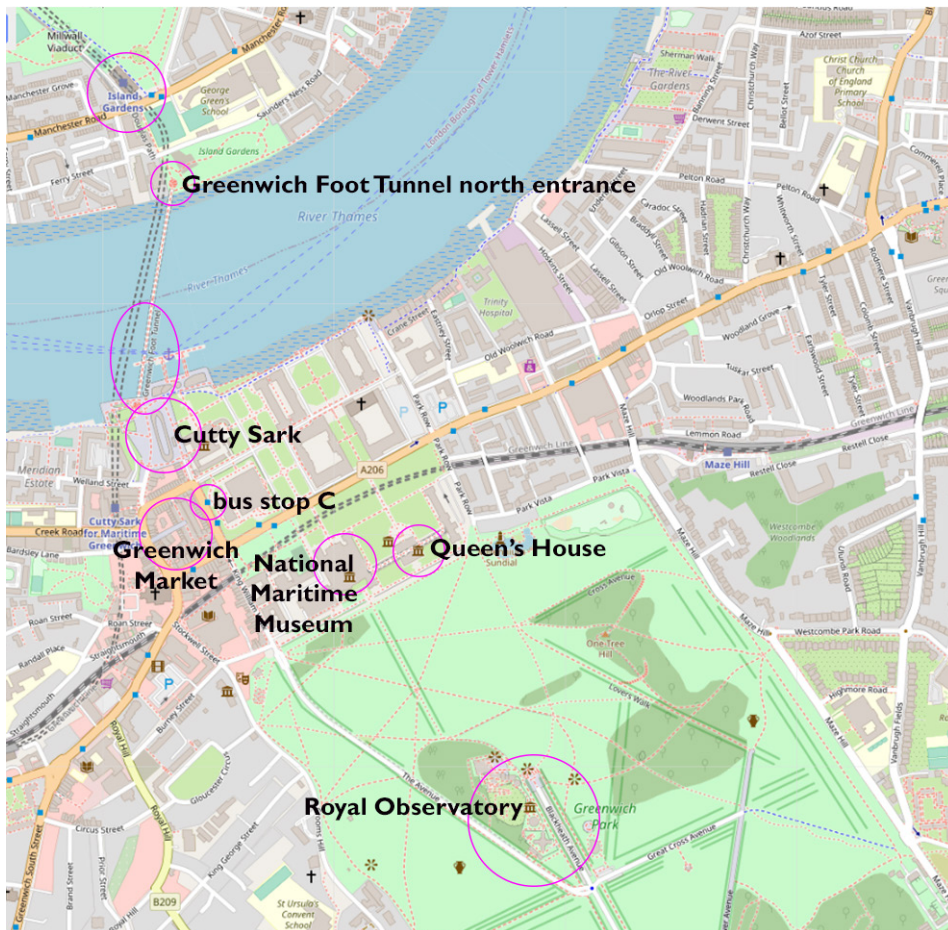
• Tube 9.36 Northern KGX to Bank; DLR towards Lewisham

• DLR Destination Island Gardens arrives 10.12

• Walk southwards, cross Manchester Rd, continue down Douglas Path into Island Gardens to the Greenwich Foot Tunnel entrance. Climb down stairs and continue your walk through the tunnel. At the southern end of the walk, climb up the stairs, exit at the Southern Foot Tunnel Entrance (by the Cutty Sark) to continue on Greenwich Church Street to a “Y” where you continue right to Creek Road.

NORTH GREENWICH

• Bus 129 from Cutty Sark bus stop C to Millenium Leisure Park South bus stop, £1.65 on your Oyster

- Flight|Emirates Air Line gondola to Royal Victoria Dock, £5 single, Oyster pay as you go (does not count towards the cap)



16.00 Walk to see the Thames Barrier and to explore the Thames Barrier Park

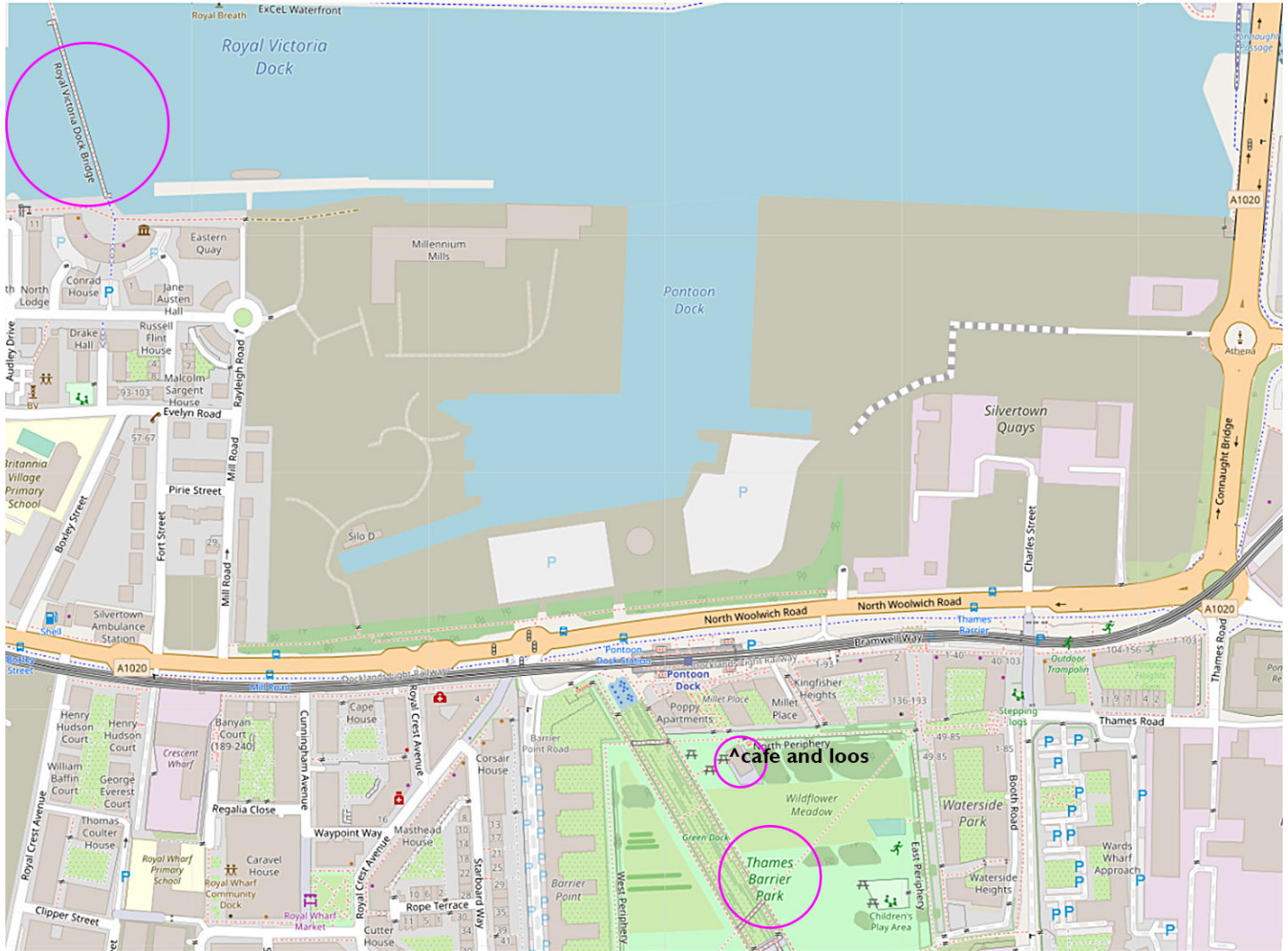

THAMES BARRIER

- Walk from the ExCel, walk across Royal Victoria Dock Bridge, continue left along the waterway to Rayleigh Road (roundabout) where you turn right and continue as it becomes Mill Road, go left at the walkway just before you reach North Woolwich Road and continue to the Pontoon Dock DLR station. Enter the Thames Barrier Park where you can.
