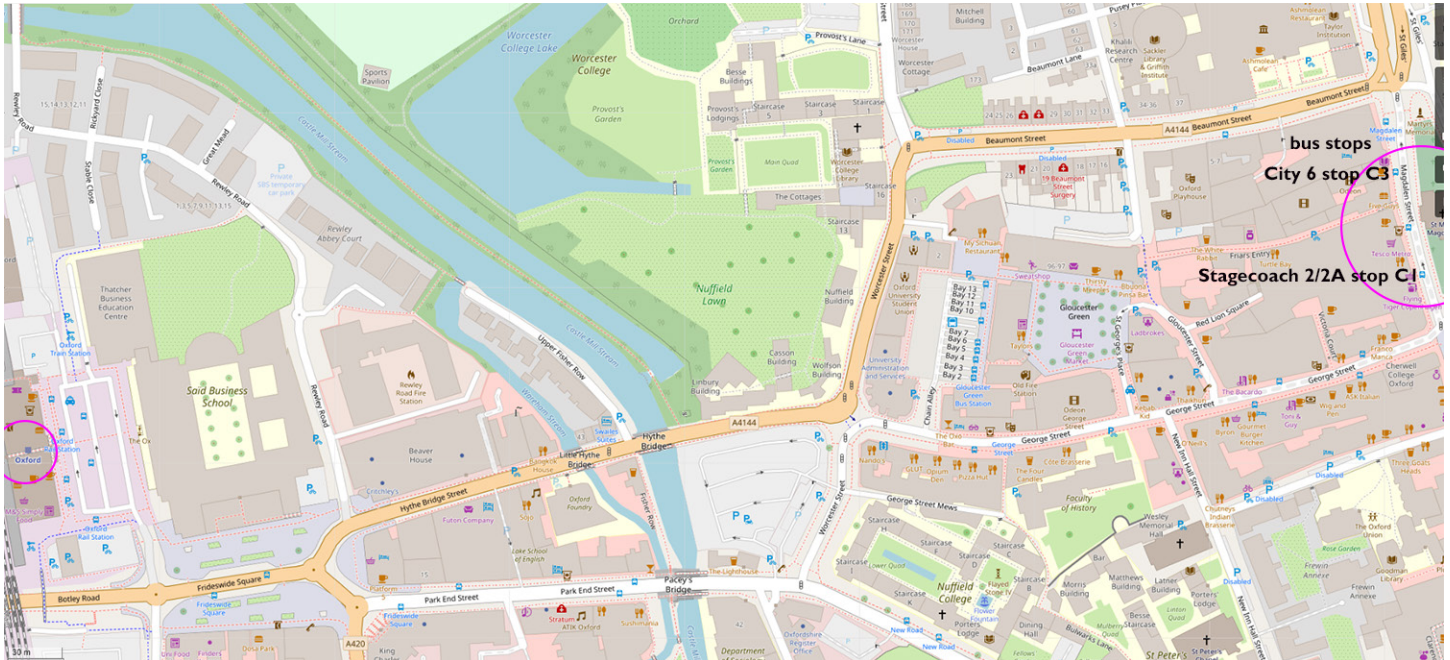


10.17 Train|Arrive Oxford (OXF). Find your way to the Magdalen Street Stagecoach 2/2A (to Kidlington) stop C1.

GETTING THERE

TRAIN

- Book your train to arrive by 10.17.



10.45 Bus|Stagecoach 2A to St Clare's Hall, 139 Banbury Road (arrives 10.51)

WALK TO BUS STOP

• Exit OXF, turn to the right (southward) to walk to Botley Road, at the roundabout continue on Frideswide Square, at the "Y" roundabout keep right to continue to the next roundabout (Hollybush Row). Turn to the left to walk on Park End Street, continue over Pacey's Bridge to a traffic signal at Worcester Street where you'll turn left. Continue on Worcester Street (it will turn into George Street), continue on George Street until it becomes Broad Street at the intersection with Magdalen Street, turn left on Magdalen Street and continue to the Stagecoach 2A bus stop C1 (past the Sainsbury Local and before the Tesco Metro).

- If you didn't add a plusBus ticket for £2.80, you can purchase a 24-hour Oxford SmartZone paper ticket, £4.50 exact change, from the bus driver.

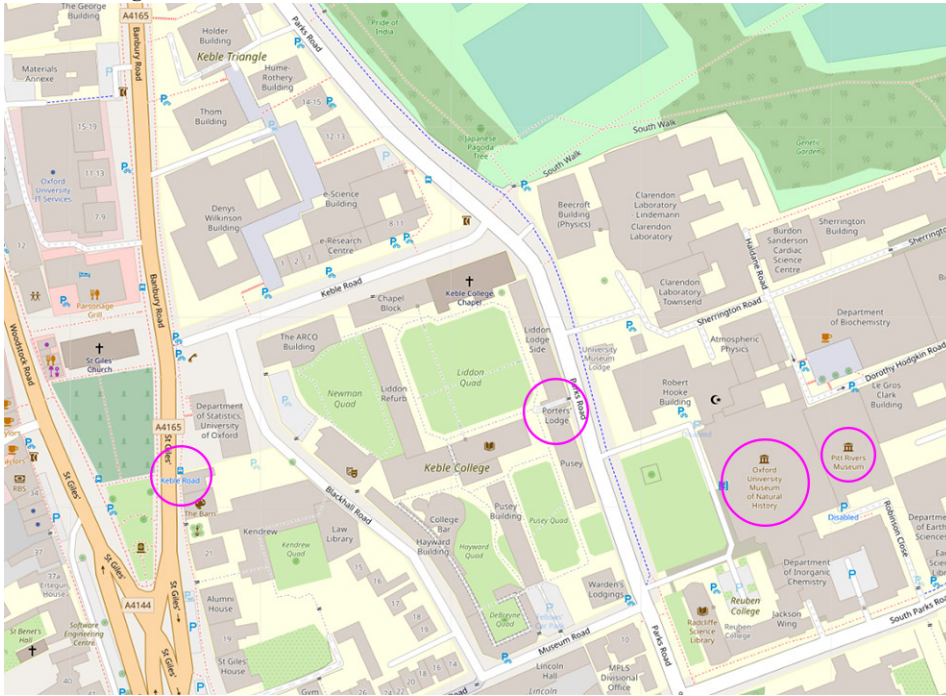

KEBLE COLLEGE

- Bus|Stagecoach 2A from the Linton Road stop (on Banbury Road) to Keble Road stop
- Walk north on St. Giles', right on Keble Road, right on Parks Road. Wait outside the Porter's Entrance

OXFORD ECO-HOUSE

26 Blandford Avenue

- Bus|City 6 stop C3 (at Magdalen Street, near Costa, see map on obverse) north-bound to First Turn (after Davenant Rd)
- Cross Woodstock Road, walk north to Blandford Avenue, turn right, walk to #26 (it's on your right).
