Designed by Foster and Arup|It has a diagrid vault of glu-lam timbers and fritted ETFE glazing.

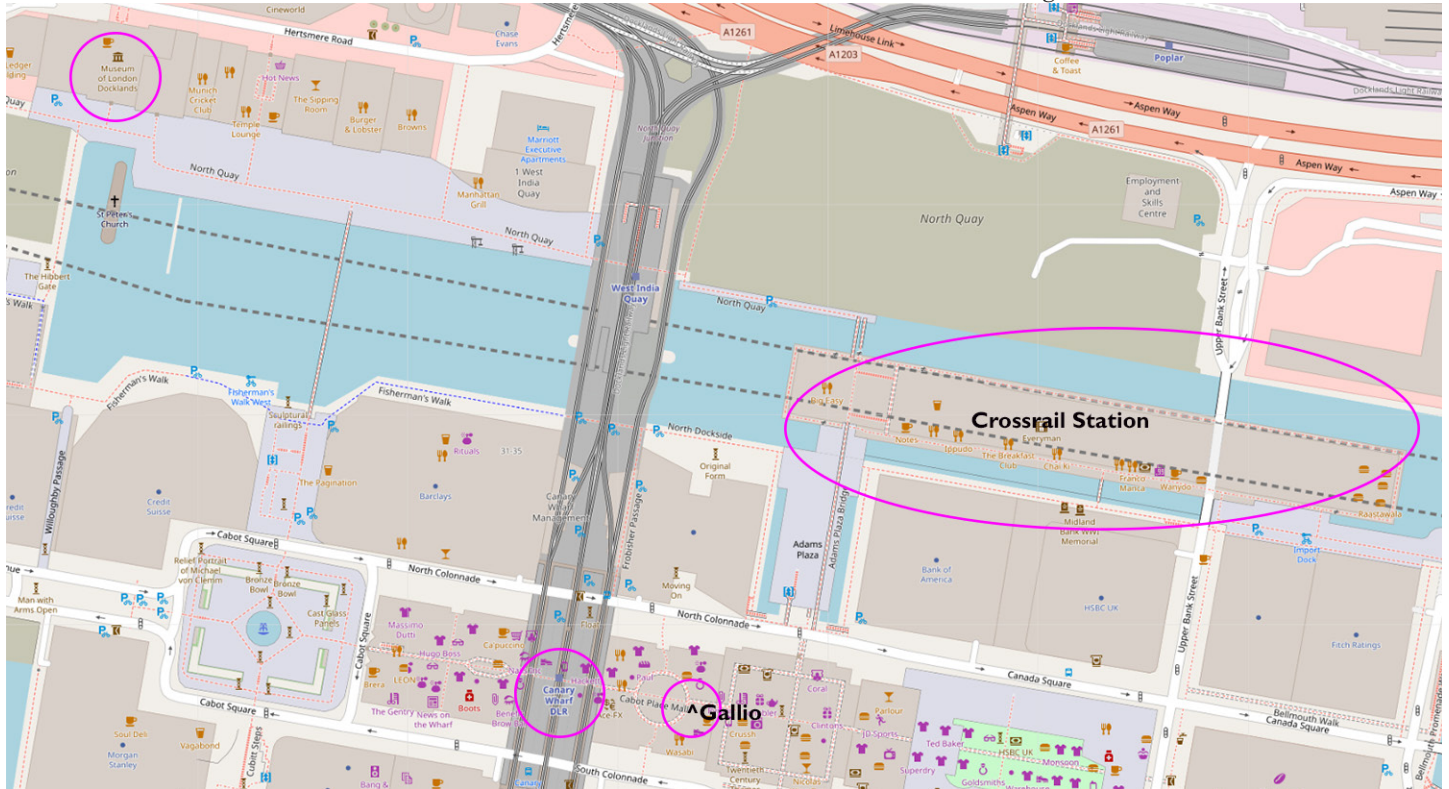
