### LONDON EYE

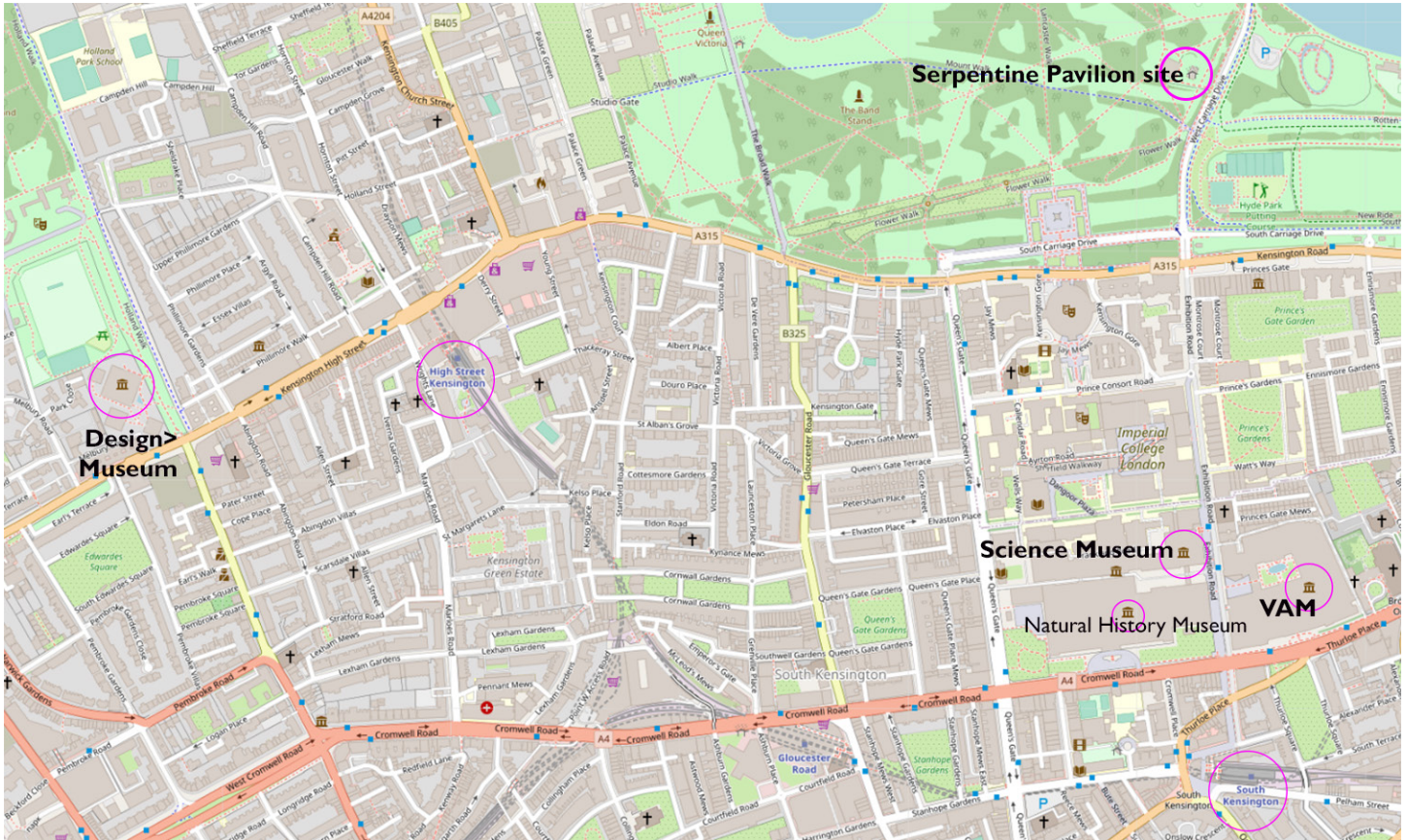
Many options. One example:
