

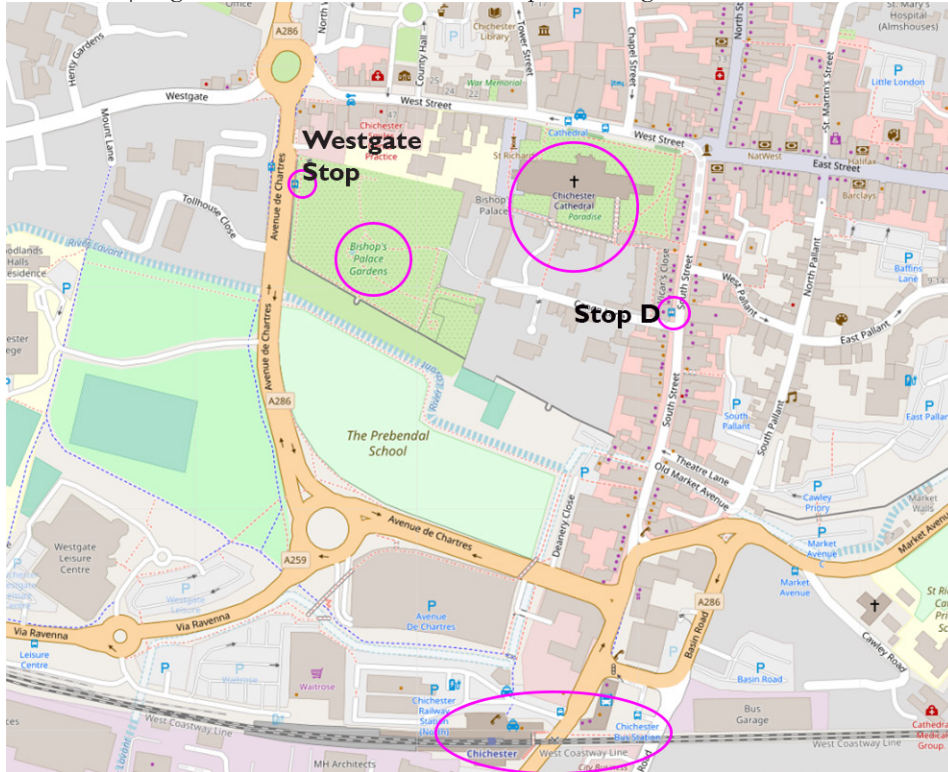

## GETTING THERE

### TRAIN

- Book your train to arrive no later than 10.10 with plusBus (£2.05 with railcard)

### BUS

- If you didn't add plusBus on your train ticket, you can purchase any of the following paper tickets from the bus driver (have exact change): return (£8.20, valid only between your outgoing stops) or a Gold Day Rider (£9.10, encompasses a broader regional area).

### WEALD & DOWNLAND LIVING MUSEUM

Town Lane; Singleton; Chichester; West Sussex PO18 0EU; <<https://www.wealddown.co.uk/>>; 7 mi. N of Chichester; open daily 10.30–18.00

- Bus|Stagecoach 60 to Midhurst
  - from South Street stop D
  - to Singleton, Grooms Yard (prior stop West Dean, Gonville Cottage)
- Walk to the Museum (5 min.)

- Bus|Return journey from Weald & Downland|Stagecoach 60 to Chichester
  - from Singleton, Grooms Yard
  - to Westgate
  - then walk through Bishop's Palace Gardens to Chichester Cathedral

- Buses run every 30 minutes M–Sat (Sun once an hour). For an up-to-date timetable visit the Stagecoach website <<https://www.stagecoachbus.com/>>.
