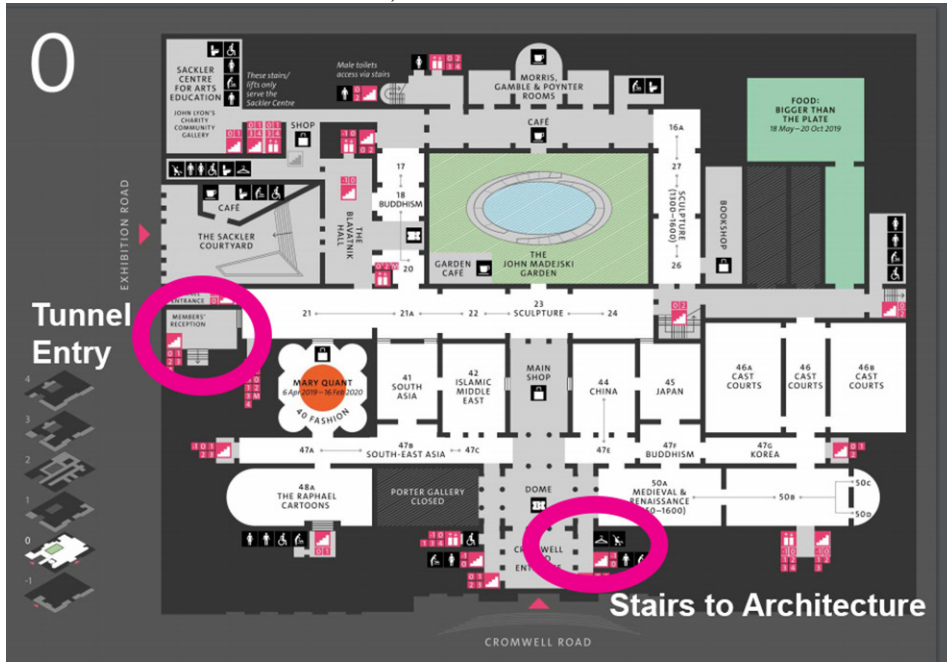
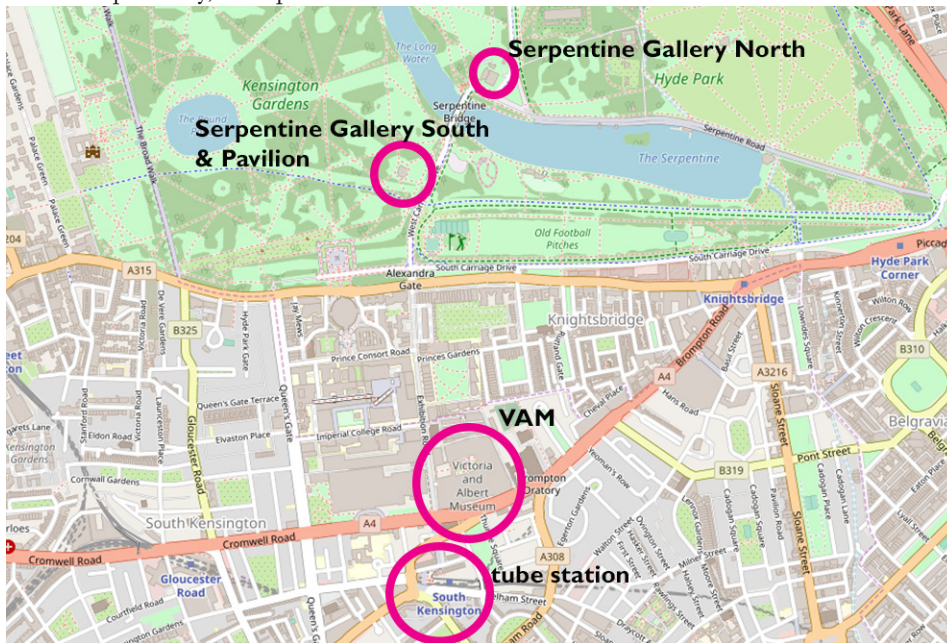


- 10.35 Sketch|St. Paul's Cathedral

- Also see|Serpentine Galleries South (closeby) and North. Both galleries are open T–Sun and require free timed tickets, booked in advance.

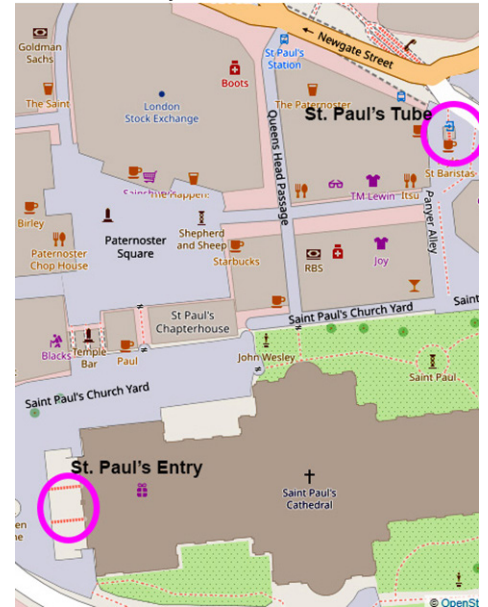

- Tube Destination|St. Paul's
- Walk through Paternoster Square and Temple Bar (gate) to the cathedral stairs (eastside)
- *Dress modestly|no bare shoulders, no shorts.*



## VICTORIA & ALBERT MUSEUM (VAM)

Cromwell Road; SW7 2RL; <<https://www.vam.ac.uk/>>; open daily 10.00–17.45, 10.00–22.00 F

- Tube Destination|South Kensington
- Use the subway (tunnel) from the tube station to walk to the basement entry of the VAM. It avoids lots of congestion, confusion, and perhaps inclement weather (wet or hot!).
