- *Dr. Stoll is one of 12 Research Consortium Review Planners to evaluate abstracts for acceptance at the 2010 Research Consortium presentations at the 2010 American Alliance of Health, Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance Convention in Indianapolis. The Research Consortium serves as the coordinating organization within AAHPERD in support of research across the disciplines and the professions served by AAHPERD. The Review Planners oversee the blind review of all research abstracts submitted. Each planner coordinates a team of reviewers to evaluate the hundreds of abstracts submitted yearly. Those abstracts that are accepted are published each spring in the Research Quarterly. Research Quarterly for Exercise and Sport (RQES) is a highly respected professional journal offering the latest research in the art and science of human movement studies. And, all authors of accepted abstracts present either a poster or free communication paper at the convention.*
