Most databases have limits on the number of concurrent users. Databases with low limits are:

CAB – 4 users

Forest Science Info. – 2 users Fish & Fisheries – 5 users

Wildlife & Ecology Studies – 1 user (Should change to 5 in the next few days)

Steps for Finding Articles

- 1. Use a database to search by topic. In most databases you can limit to a specific journal using the Advanced Search.
- 2. Some databases contain the full-text of journal articles. If the article is **not** full text in the database, click on the Link Source icon. If the article is available electronically through another library database, there will be a link. Otherwise, click on "Check to see if UI Library Owns the Journal or Magazine" to see if the library has the journal in print. Open up the record to see the holdings (years owned) and the call number. Print journals are on the 2nd floor.

Journal List (linked from library's homepage)

- Use the Journal List to search for journal titles. If the library owns the journal there will be links to the electronic version (may be several different electronic options) and/or a record for the print version.
 - The journal list is helpful to use if:
 - You have a citation and are looking for a specific article in a specific journal.
 - You can use the links to the electronic journals to browse issues of journals.
 Usually you will go to a screen listing the table of contents with the links to the articles (either pdf or html).
