


## SIr John Soane Day in London

## GETTING THERE.

• To Soane Museum

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Tube. King's Cross Piccadilly Line to Holborn station, walk south on Kingsway, left on Gate Street which bends to the south to Lincoln's Inn Fields, turn left, the museum is down the block on your left.

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To Dulwich Pavilion

Tube. Holborn Central Line transfer at Bank to Northern Line to London Bridge.

Train. Go to North Dulwich. Any time day return £4.30.

Walk. South on Dulwich Villiage Road, at the "Y" take either Gallery Road or College Road to Dulwich Picture Gallery. (See map to the far left.)

• To Thornton Tomasetti

Walk. Return to Dulwich North train station.

Train. Return to London Bridge

Tube. London Bridge Northern Line to Angel.

Walk. South on St. John's Street to Myddleton Street, go right and continue through Exmouth Market to Pine Street, go left and Thornton Tomasetti is on your left. (See map to the left.)
