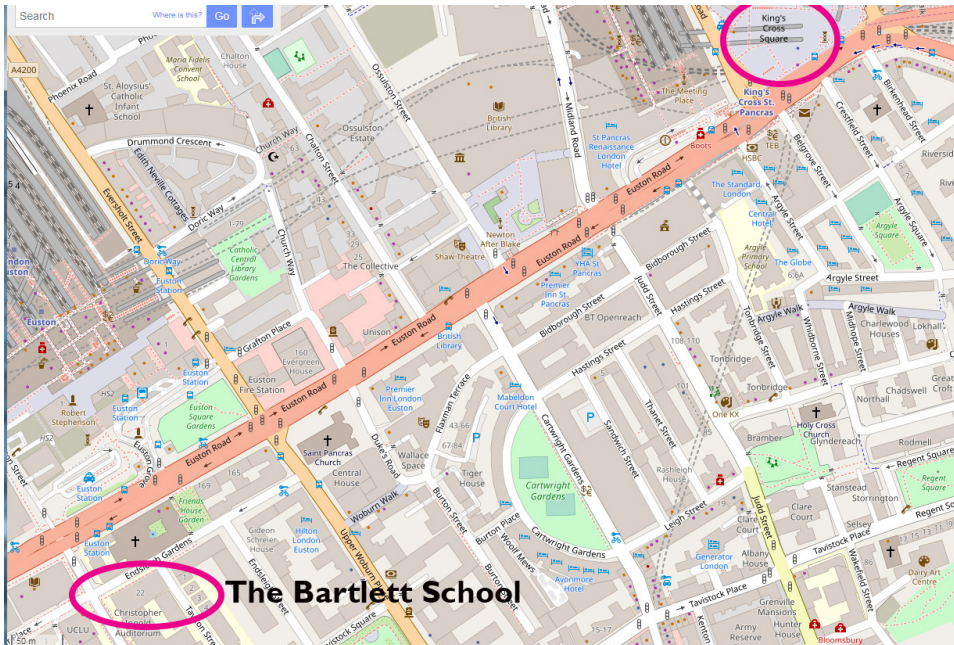


Architecture Shows and Bloomsbury

Getting There.

Walk. From Victoria Hall to King's Cross Square. Cross Euston Road and go right (west) on Euston Road to Upper Woburn Place. Turn left for one block to Enleigh Gardens. Go west two blocks to the Bartlett School of Architecture, 22 Gordon Street.

12:00 Visit the Building Centre, Store Street, London WC1E <7BT <https://www.buildingcentre.co.uk/>>. Free.

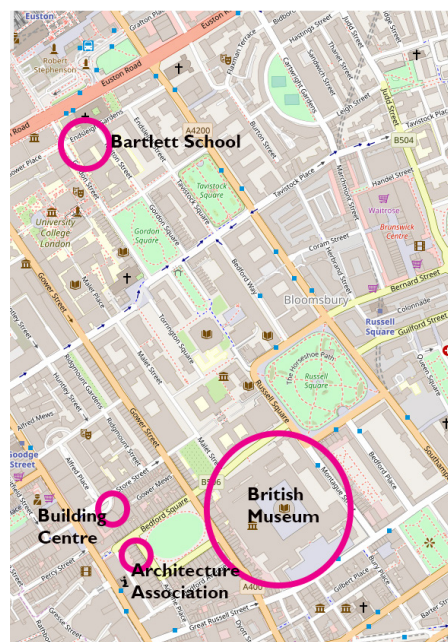

You can't see it all in one day, so hack the museum looking for daylighted spaces—the Grand Court with Foster's glass lid is obvious (and cool), but most of the upper floor galleries are also skylighted.



Walk. From the Bartlett School go south on Gordon Street to Tavistock Place, turn right on Tavistock Place, go across Gower Street to Ridgeman Gardens, turn left, go two blocks, turn right on Store Street to the Building Centre. Both the Architecture Association and the British Museum are within two blocks of the Building Centre.

Bruce has a favorite café inside Russell Square. Great place to people watch and enjoy a good cuppa and/or Italian fare.
