


To Eco-House

Train. 09:21 Great Western from Paddington (PAD) to 0xford (OXF) ar 10:17

Off-peak day return £18.10 or advance singles out and back £8.10; plusBus £2.65

Walk. From Oxford Train Station to Magdalen Street bus stop via Botley Road, Hythe Bridge Street, Worcester Street, and Beaumont Street. The bus stop is just to your right when you reach St. Giles. (about 15 min.).

Bus. Take the City 6 bus to First Turn.

Walk. Cross Woodstock Road to Blandford Avenue walk to the Eco-House at 26 Blandford Avenue (it's on your right).

Bus. Take City 6 bus from First Turn to Lathbury Road.

Walk south on Woodstock Road, turn left on Staverton Road, go one block to Banbury Road, turn right to 121 Banbury Road.

- Oxford Covered Market, Market St. Oxford, OX1 3DZ http://oxford-coveredmarket.co.uk/traders/ open until 17:00.
- Tower Ascents and Sundial Trail; Carfax Tower OX1 1ET (£1, open until 17.30); University Church of St. Mary the Virgin OX7 4AH (on High Street between Oriel and Catte Streets; Church £0, tower £3; open until 18.00) https://www.britainexpress.com/cities/oxford/map.htm.
