

Glasgow Exploration—Mackintosh Day




10:30 The Lighthouse (free) http://www.thelighthouse.co.uk/

• Walk from Queen St. Station west toward Buchanan Street, cross Buchanan to West Nile Street, left to beyond Gordon Street, look for the Lighthouse on your left-it's down the alley.


• Subway. Buchanan Street to Ibrox. From the Lighthouse go to and walk up Buchanan Street to the station. Walking instructions/map from Ibrox on next page.

Glasgow Subway All Day ticket (unlimited travel) is £4.20 at the station

Note: Riverside Museum by Zaha Hadid is accessible from the Kelvinhall station.

GETTING THERE.

• Leaving Ibrox station, turn right and continue to the end of Copland Road, cross here and continue right walking along Paisley Road West until you reach the junction. Cross the road here and take a direct left walking across the flyover, continue along Dumbreck Road until you reach the entrance to Bellahouston Park on your right. (Marked Glasgow Ski Centre/ House for an Art Lover).

Enjoy Glasgow, strolling pedestrian-friendly Buchanan Street and taking tea at the Willows Tea House (corner of Buchanan Street and Mitchell Lane-open 9a-6:30p <http://willowstearooms.co.uk>), exploring the Argyll Arcade (Buchanan Street and Argyll Street), and whatever else strikes your fancy! • Subway from Ibrox to Cowcaddens station, alight and use the underpass beneath Cowcaddens Road to Rose Street, right on Renfrew Street continue to Dalhousie Street, the Reid Building is on your right.
