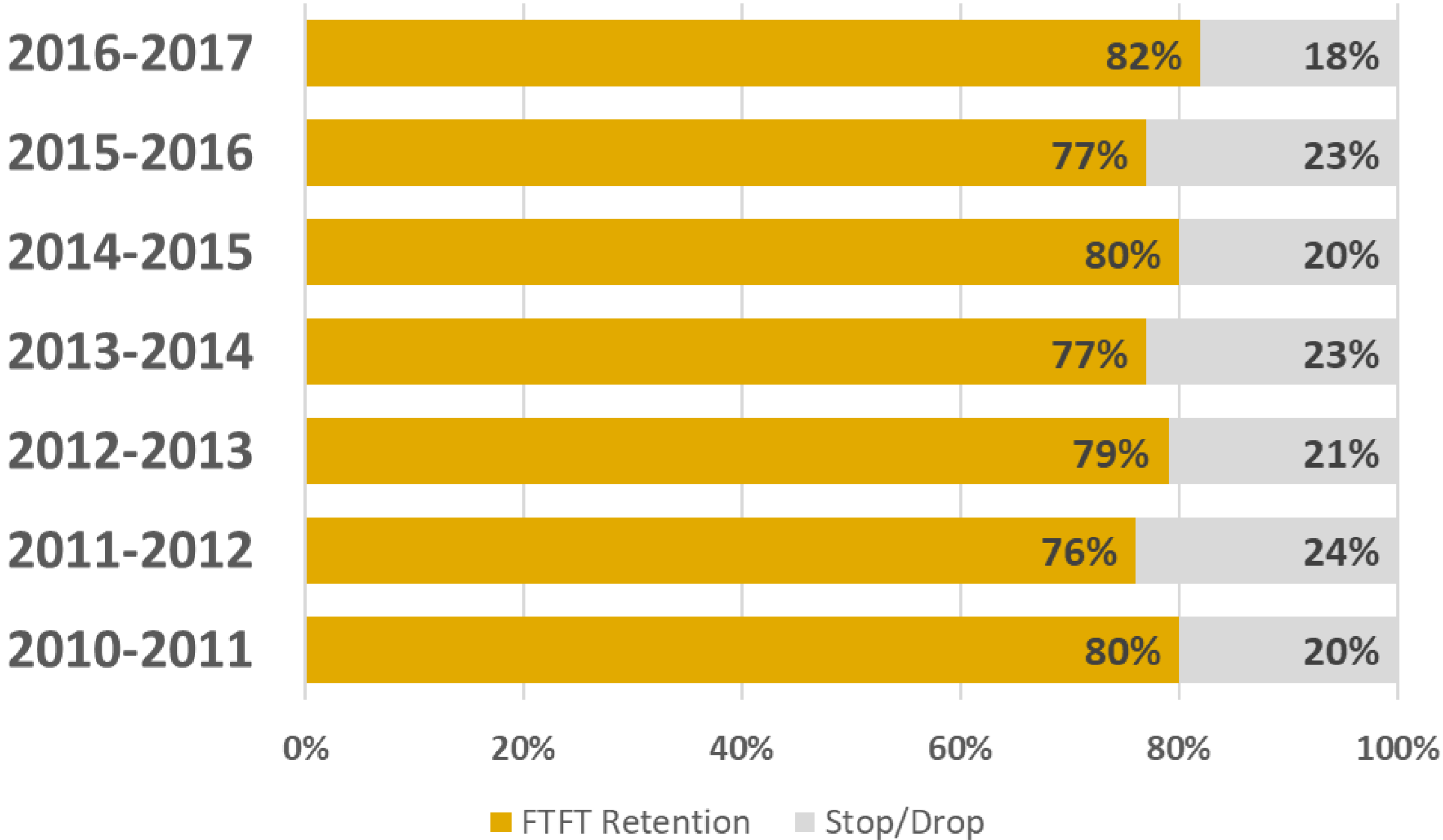

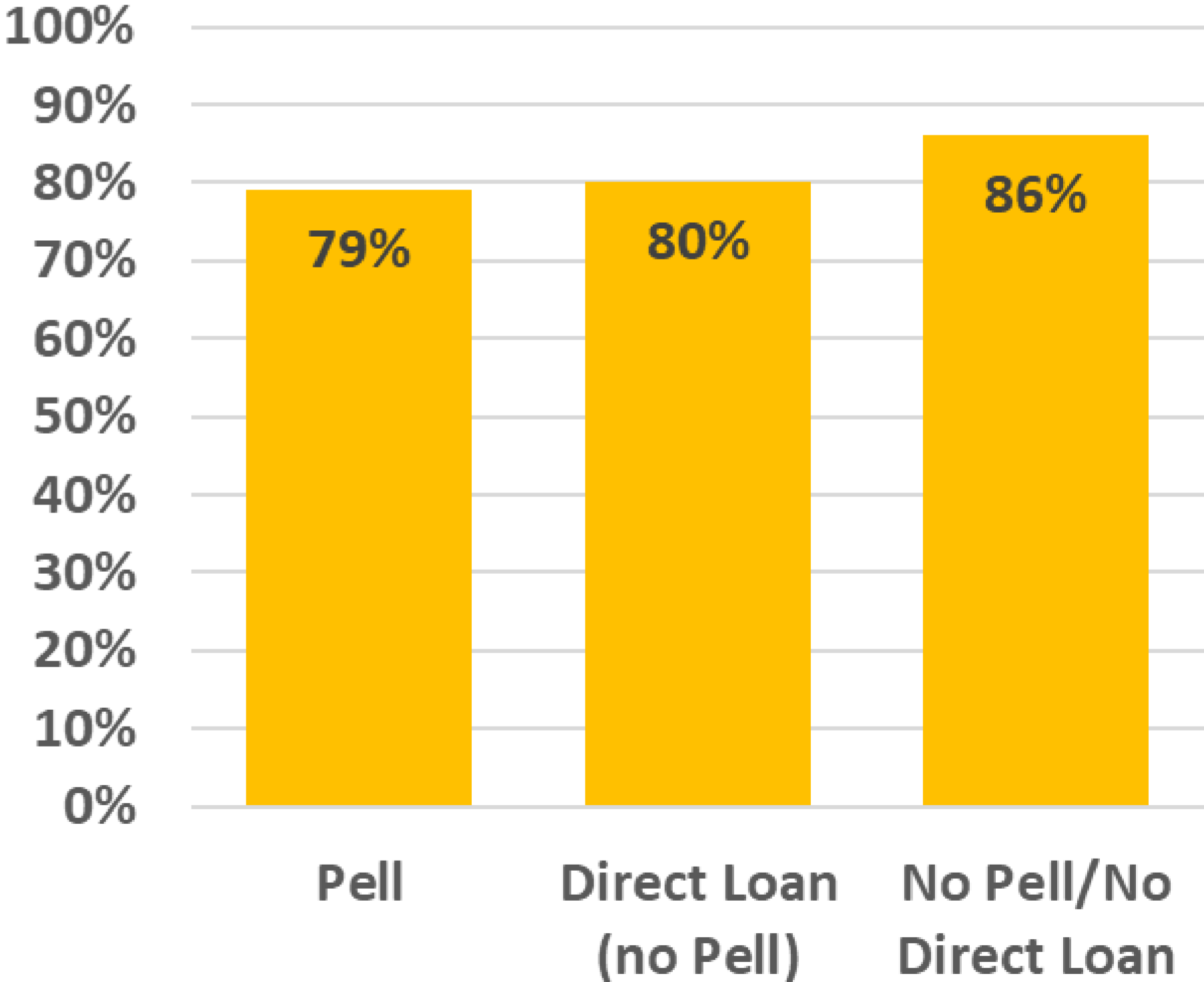

Freshman Retention (FTFT Students) 2010-2017



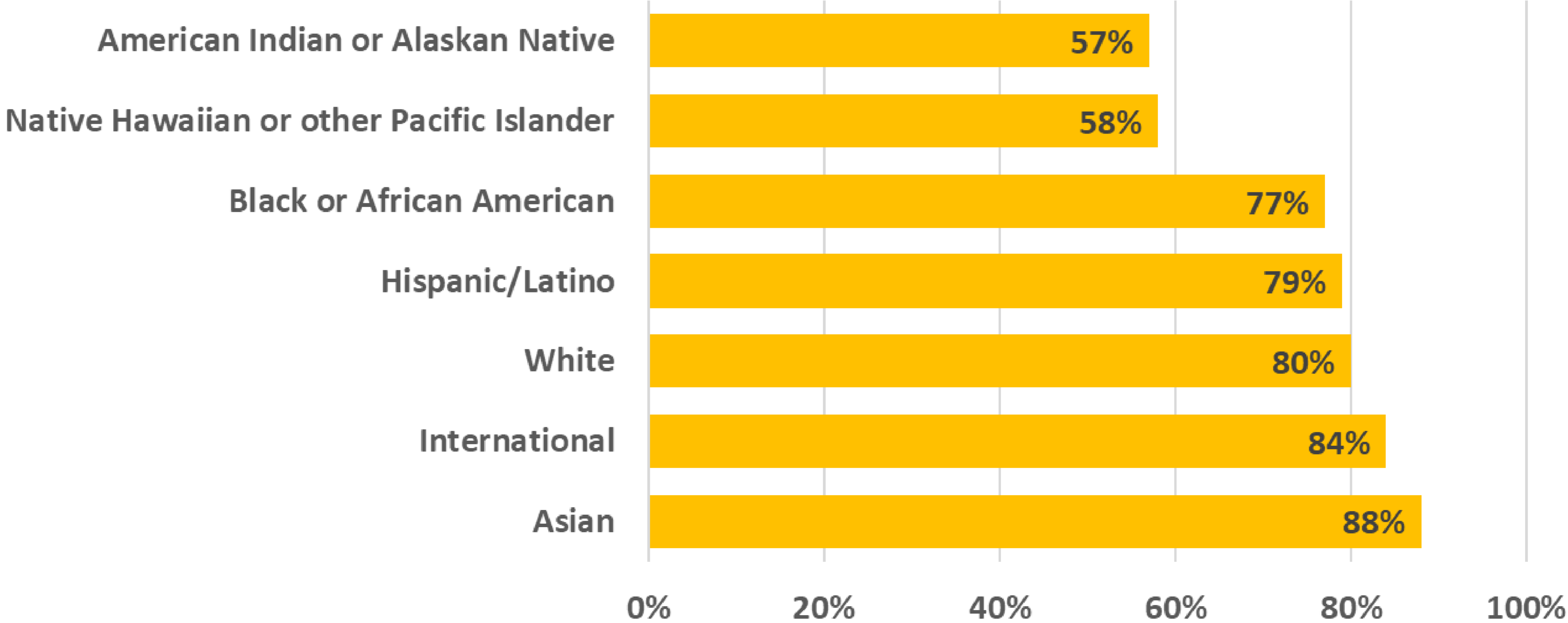
FTFT Retention Rates by Pell/Direct Loan Status for Cohort 2016-2017

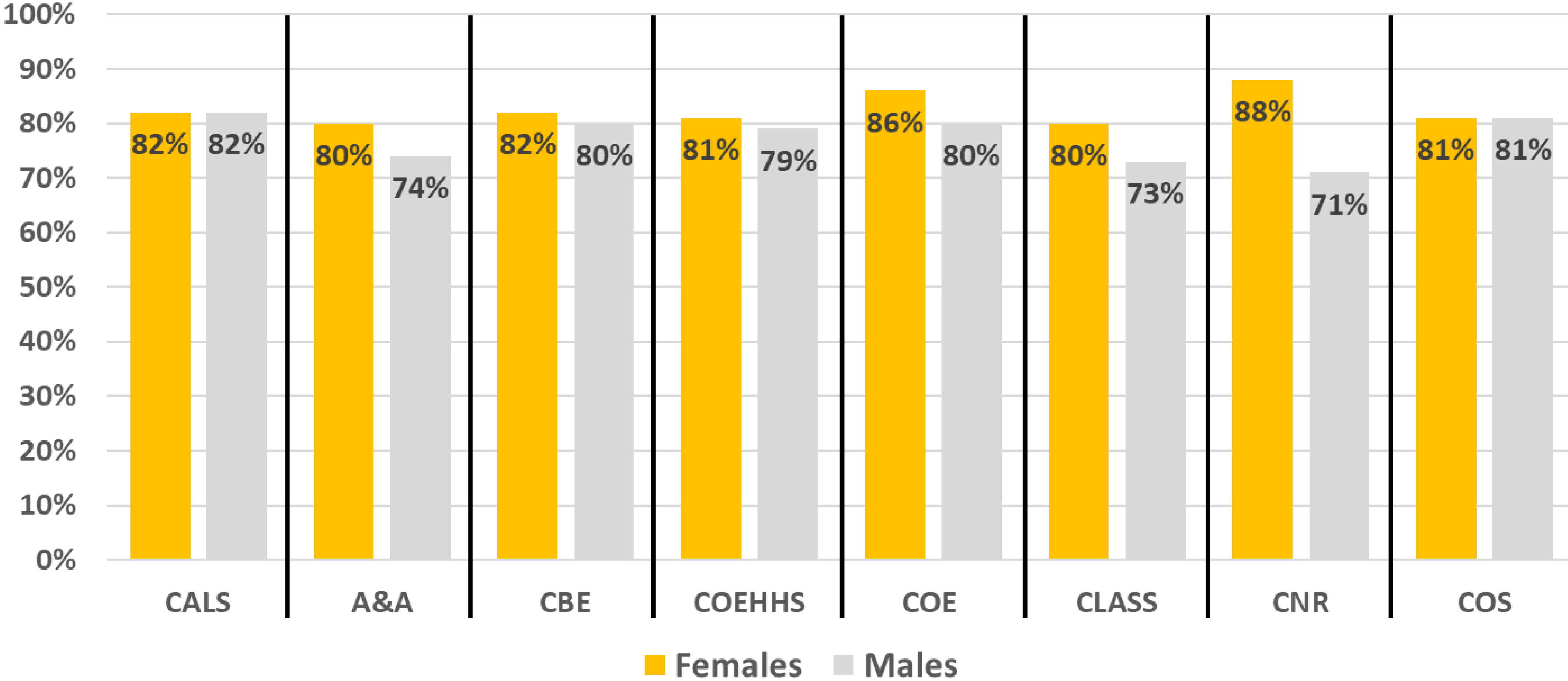
FTFT Retention Rates by Race for 2014-2015-2016 Cohorts

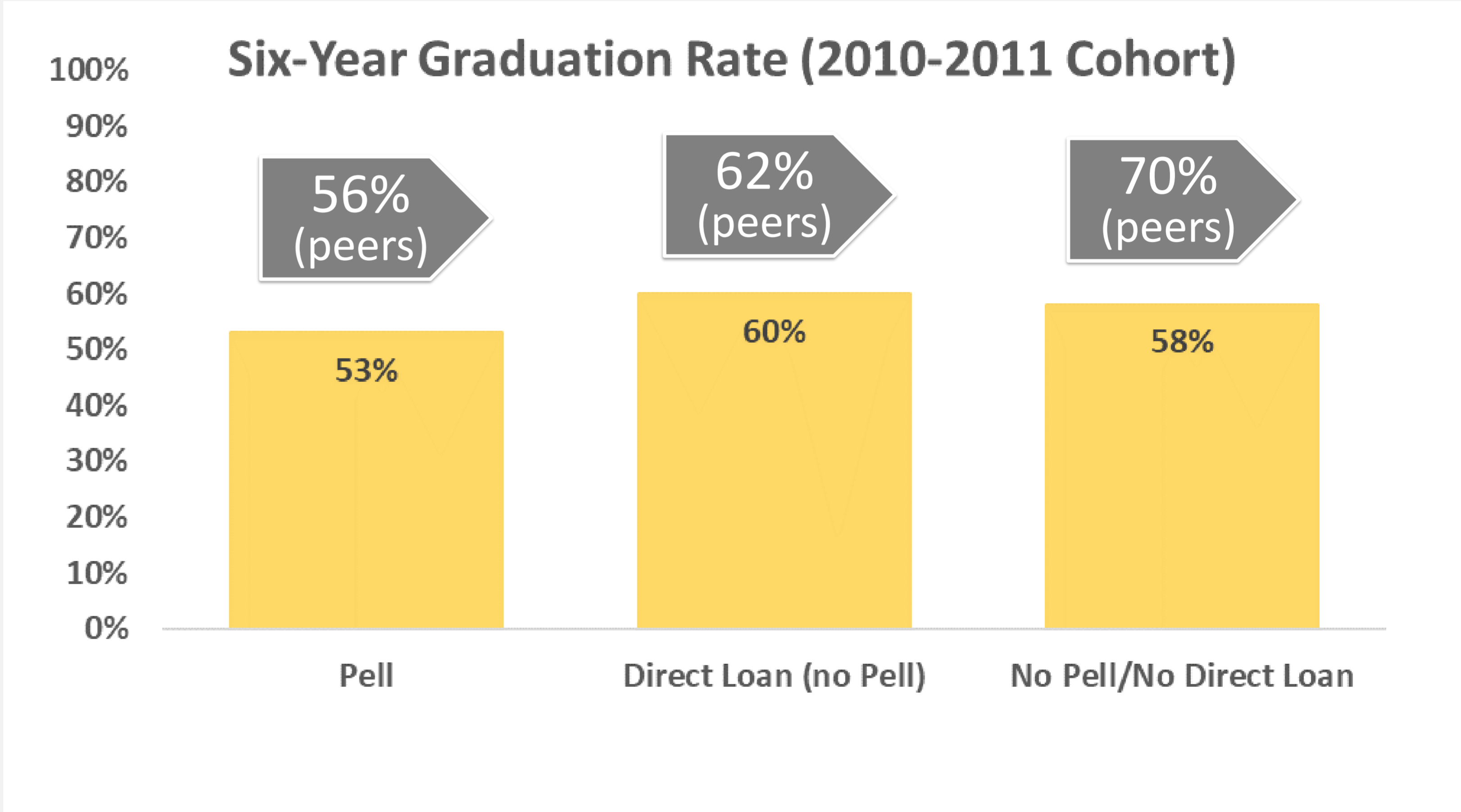

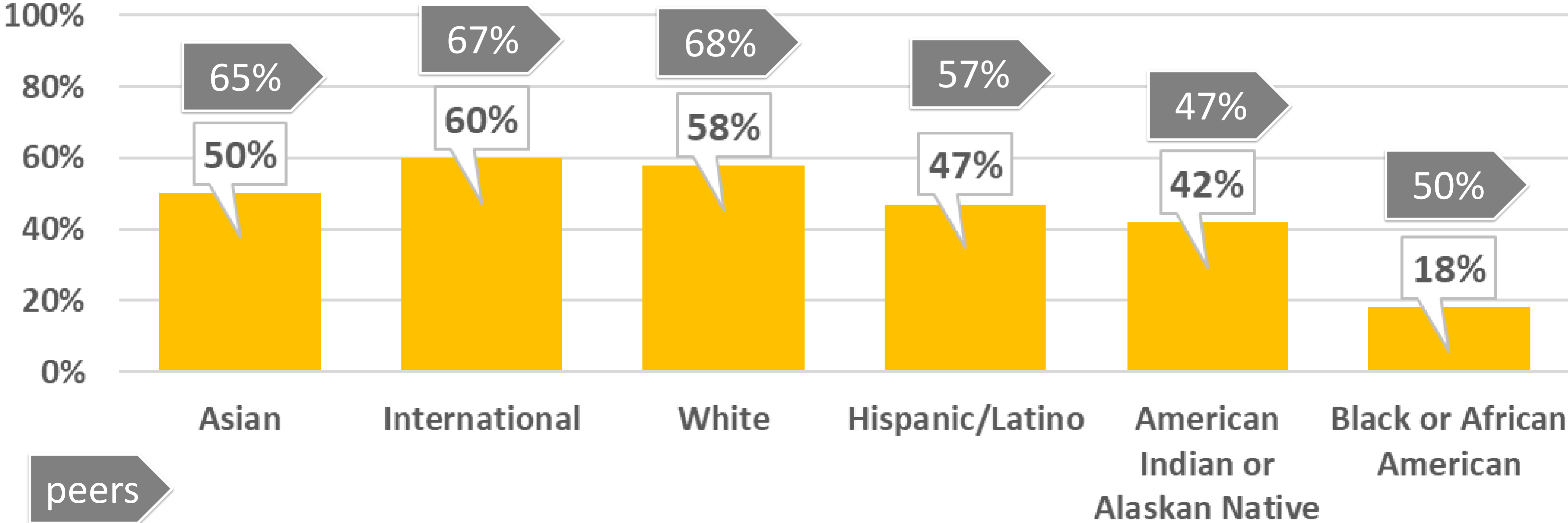

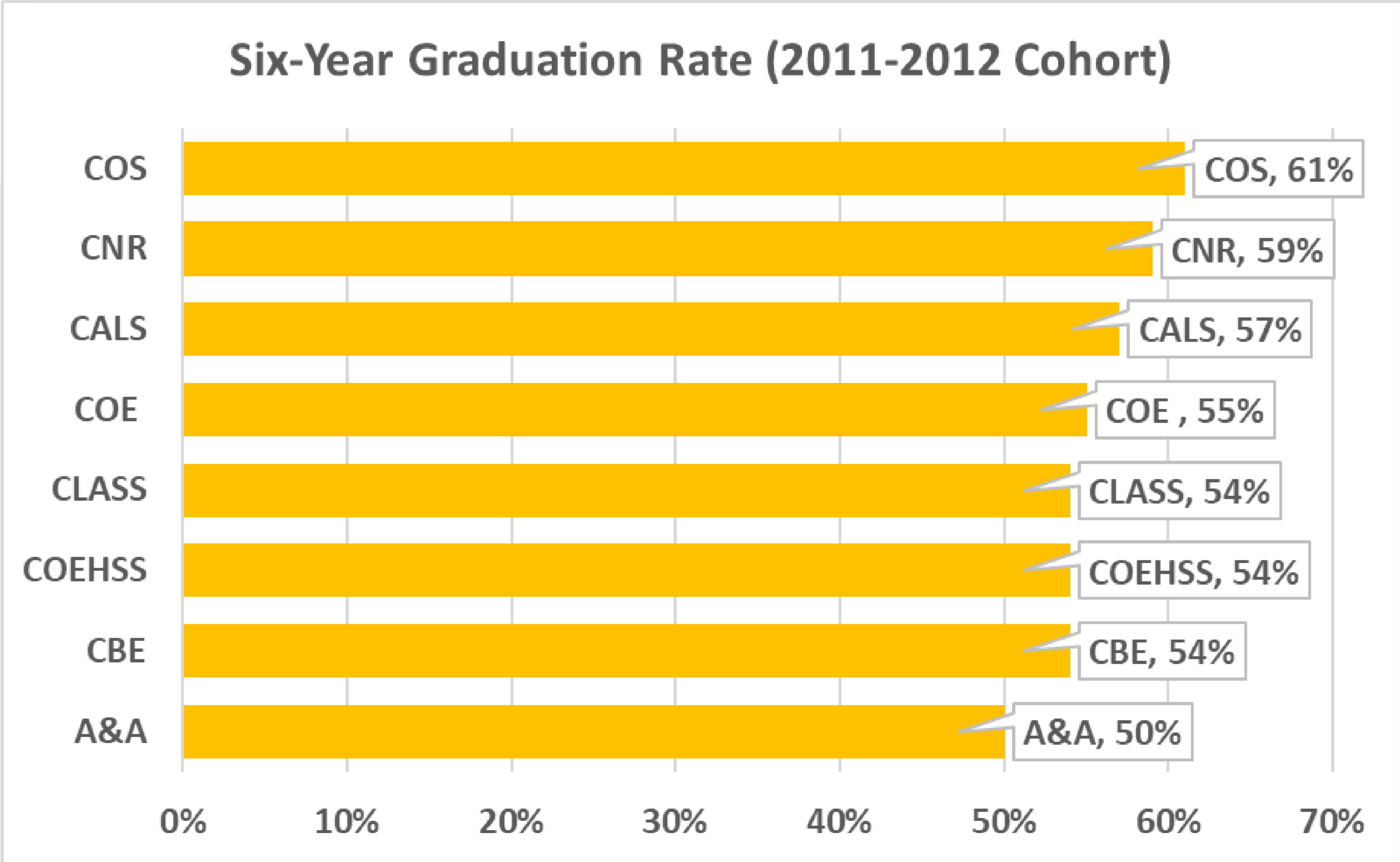

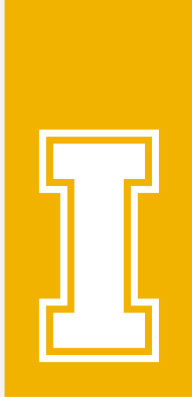
6-Year Graduation Rate by Race/Ethnicity (2010-2011 Cohort)



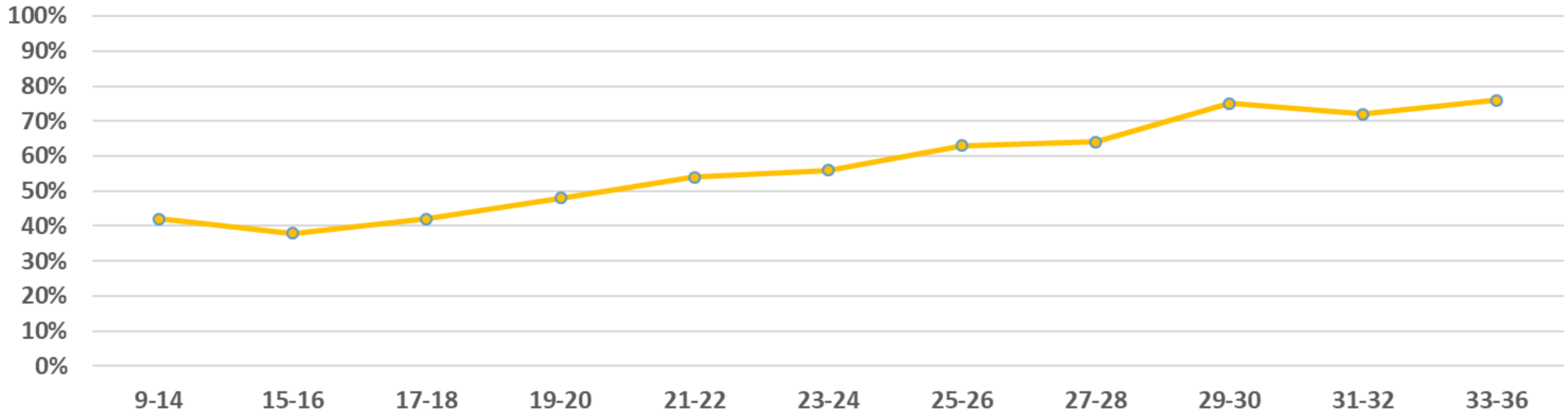

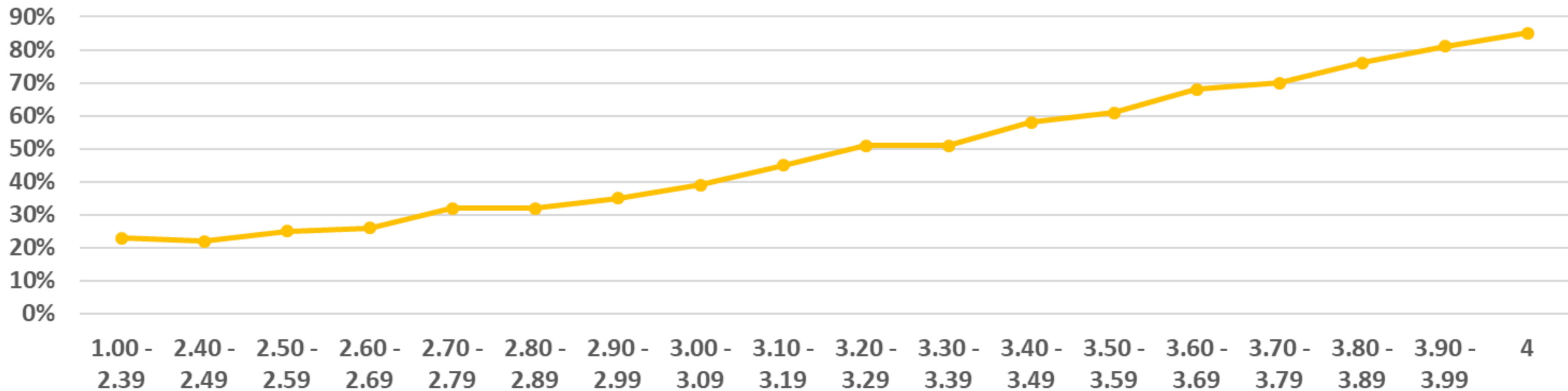
