- 1) Go over the video and article before you start the quiz (and make sure you find the first page of the article – sometimes the links take you into the middle).
- 2) You have one opportunity to take the quiz, so do not exit until you are done.
- 3) You are free to answer the questions while looking at the links.
- 4) You are expected to answer the questions on your own.
- 5) You won't know if you answered correctly until after the due date (the due date is given on Bblearn). You should not see a score before then.
