In this section please record the trips you make and any related trip expenses for the <u>next 24 hours you are in Idaho</u>. The information you record will be used by the state to understand traffic patterns. This information is critical for getting future highway funding for the state.

A trip is <u>one-way</u> travel from one location to another for a particular purpose—such as going home, to work, to school, or to a restaurant. You also need to record, as a separate trip, your <u>one-way return trip</u> back from these locations. The use of all kinds of ground transportation should be recorded, including walking and bicycle trips. Stops that are not part of the overall trip/destination, but are generally along the route, should NOT be considered a separate trip.

Example: Record one trip for driving from home to work, and record another for driving from work back to home. If after leaving home you stopped for fuel and coffee on the way to work, this extra stop would be considered part of your trip to work. Therefore, your expenditures on fuel & coffee would be recorded in the Trip Expenses portion of the diary.

Record any prepaid purchases of <u>Idaho travel products and services</u> in the box below. Prepaid purchases might include such things as car rental, lodging, guided or outfitted trips, a ski package, and so on, that you paid for in advance of your trip in Idaho.


