**SPONSOR:** Howard Hughes Medical Institute (HHMI)

**PROGRAM:** Inclusive Excellence Initiative (IE3)

**LIMIT ON NUMBER OF FULL PROPOSALS PER INSTITUTION: 1**

HHMI will only allow one Intent to Apply to be submitted per institution.

**LIMIT ON NUMBER OF FULL PROPOSALS PER PI: 1**

**AWARD:** IE3 grants will be non-renewable \$1 million awards (direct costs), payable in equal installments over five years.

**OVERVIEW:** The Research and Faculty Development (RFD) team in the Office of Research and Economic Development is requesting notice of intent (NOI) to indicate interest in submitting a proposal to the Howard Hughes Medical Institute (HHMI) Inclusive Excellence Initiative (IE3) Competition. The University of Idaho can serve as the lead institution on a single application to this program. Individuals interested in serving as the Program Director on an IE3 proposal must submit a [Notice of Intent](#) to RFD by 5:00 p.m. PT on **Monday, June 3, 2019**.

**SYNOPSIS:** Today, the majority of people coming to college intending to study science are what, a generation ago, were called “non-traditional” students. This new majority includes students who begin at a two-year school and transfer to a four-year university, students who are first in their family to attend college (first-generation students), and persons who identify as belonging to racial, ethnic, socioeconomic, and other groups underrepresented in science. The HHMI Inclusive Excellence initiative fosters a learning community of college and university faculty and administrators who are engaged in the process of increasing their institution’s capacity for inclusion of all students, especially students who belong to groups underrepresented in the sciences.
