

# Limited Submission Funding Opportunity

**SPONSOR:** National Science Foundation

**PROGRAM:** Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation (LSAMP)

**LIMIT ON NUMBER OF FULL PROPOSALS PER INSTITUTION:** 1 per track

Only one proposal may be submitted by an eligible institution per LSAMP track (Alliance, Bridges to the Doctorate, Louis Stokes Regional Centers of Excellence in Broadening Participation, Pre-Alliance Planning)

**LIMIT ON NUMBER OF PROPOSALS PER PI:** Alliances (new, existing, and pre-alliance planning) = 1; Bridges to the Doctorate = 1; Louis Stokes Regional Centers of Excellence in Broadening Participation = no limit

**AWARD:** Varies by project type

**OVERVIEW:** The Research and Faculty Development (RFD) team in the Office of Research and Economic Development is requesting notice of intent to apply for the National Science Foundation (NSF) Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation (LSAMP) program, a limited submission funding opportunity. The University of Idaho can serve as the lead institution on one proposal per track to the LSAMP program, and the University will use an internal review process to determine which proposals will be submitted to NSF. Interested individuals must submit an NOI to RFD by 5:00 p.m. PT on Monday, **July 15, 2019**.

**SYNOPSIS:** The Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation (LSAMP) program invests in the nation's colleges and universities to aid student success at all STEM pathways thereby creating a new generation of STEM discoverers for the STEM enterprise nationally and internationally. The overall goal of the LSAMP program is to help diversify the nation's STEM workforce by funding institutions of higher education to implement comprehensive, evidence-based, and sustained approaches to broadening the participation of students historically underrepresented in STEM disciplines (African Americans, Hispanic Americans, American Indians or Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians or Other Pacific Islanders) primarily at the undergraduate (including community college) and post baccalaureate levels. The program also supports the production of scholarly research and dissemination activities on the topic of broadening participation in STEM.

Project types under this program include: (1) Alliances (e.g., STEM Pathways Implementation-Only Alliance projects, STEM Pathways and Research Alliances, Bridge to the Baccalaureate (B2B) Alliances); (2) Bridge to the Doctorate (BD) Activity; (3) Louis Stokes Regional Centers of Excellence in Broadening Participation; (4) Pre-Alliance Planning projects; and (5) Conferences and other supplemental funding opportunities.
