
Balinese Tika (temporal cycles): Some Lecture Notes

Intersection of different time cycles, each of which expresses different spiritual god and demon influences.

Only example in our society when the 6th day of the week Friday intersects with the 13th day of the month Friday the 13th intersection of weekly and monthly cycles

Simplest is a five and seven day cycle, part of a six month and 420 day year. Others can be up to cycles of 10,000 years.

Daily Demons

Result: six 35-day months (each month under the influence of a different god, with each day also under the influence of a specific demon and god). The resulting 210-day cycle is then repeated to create a 420-day cycle or year. So that on each day is influenced by a god of the month, as well as god of the day and demon of the day.

Time repeats cyclically
